GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS ON 22nd AUGUST, 2026

Atmospheric Prelude & Setting

Nestled amidst the tranquil, idyllic greenery on the outskirts of Kolkata — the historic City of Joy and India's primal capital — the Vedic Village offered a harmonious blend of rural rustic allure and modern luxury. Surrounded by thatched, air-conditioned dwellings, serene waterbodies echoing the gentle splash of local fish, and whispering coconut palms, the venue set a poetic backdrop for a historic milestone: the 50th Anniversary of the UCO Bank SC/ST & OBC Employees' Council.

By 10:00 AM, driven by immense enthusiasm, over 600 delegates, distinguished guests, and esteemed invitees gathered in the grand Conference Hall, exquisitely embellished to commemorate half a century of relentless movement and solidarity. Notably, the revered Founder and Chairman of the Council, **Shri B. C. Poddar**, despite experiencing frail health, demonstrated indomitable willpower and affection for the fraternity by gracing the occasion, escorted by dedicated volunteer members.

Ceremonial Inauguration & Floral Tributes

At precisely 11:00 AM, the historic proceedings commenced. The Chairman, **Shri B. C. Keynote Address & Website Launch by Shri Kishore Makwanaji

- **Mammoth Golden Jubilee Celebrations:** Shri Makwanaji, expressed his pleasure at witnessing the mammoth Golden Jubilee Celebration of UCO Bank SC/ST & OBC Employees' Council with presence of a large number of vibrant members from all across the Country. He congratulated the Host Unit for successfully organising such a massive event in a beautiful ambiance with utmost perfection and discipline. While recognising the contribution of our founding General Secretary Shri B.C. Poddar for ensuring protection of rights of the members against discrimination at work place he linked his competence to equitably stitched purpose with active participation in the affairs of the Council to impose belief of strength in all the members.
- **Historical Reflections & Struggles:** Shri Makwanaji commended the Council on completing 50 years of courageous fight for justice, dignity, and rights. - **Constitutional Vision:** He emphasized that Baba Saheb Dr. B. R. Ambedkar framed the Constitution to ensure rights and socio-economic justice for marginalized communities, a mission carried forward by the National Commission.
- **Launch of Council Website:** At the request of the General Secretary, Shri Makwanaji officially inaugurated the newly designed **Official Website of the Council** by pressing the digital console, displaying the Council's glorious history and achievements across the Auditorium's giant screens.
- **Assurance:** He reassured the fraternity that the National Commission's doors remain open at all times for the prompt redressal of grievances.

5. Address by Dr. Partha Biswas

Hon'ble Member of the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, **Dr. Partha Biswas** addressed the assembly:

- **Scope of Service:** He highlighted that over 20 crore SC/ST citizens fall under the protective umbrella of the Commission, noting that grassroots bank employees remain directly connected to these communities.
- **Economic Vision & Viksit Bharat:** Dr. Biswas recalled Baba Saheb Ambedkar's scholarly contributions to Indian banking and financial structure. He asserted that the Prime Minister's vision of *Viksit Bharat* can only be realized when the banking sector efficiently extends its services to the underprivileged, urging administrative bodies to bridge implementation gaps.

Address by the Founder & Chairman, Dada Saheb Shri B. C. Poddar

Amid a poignant silence followed by thunderous, sustained applause, the venerated Founder and Life Time Chairman, **Shri B. C. Poddar** took the microphone, addressing the house with his familiar, gentle cadence: *"My Dear Brothers and Sisters!"*

- **Emotional Reconnect:** Dada Saheb Shri B. C. Poddar shared that despite physical discomfort, the love and vibrancy of the assembly revitalized his spirit.
- **Historical Genesis:** He reminisced about joining UCO Bank in 1974 following nationalization (1969), recognizing the adversity faced by SC/ST employees. This prompted the formation of the Council in 1976, starting with a mere 15 officers and 135 staff members.
- **Legacy & Charge to Youth:** Expressing immense gratification at seeing the enthusiasm on the young leaders' faces, he assured them of his unwavering mental support. He urged members to work dedicatedly for the advancement of UCO Bank, the Council, and society, while requesting the Officials of the National Commission to maintain their steadfast support for the Council's legitimate causes.

Address by Shri Abhimannu Rajak (Chief General Manager & CLO)

Commencing his speech with the greeting *"Jai Bhim! Jai Bharat!"*, CGM, Shri Abhimannu Rajak reflected on the Council's 50-year milestone:

10th NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON 23rd AUGUST, 2026

Morning Assembly & Inaugural Ceremony

Beneath a canopy of gentle morning sunlight and a refreshing breeze that whispered through the vibrant countryside, the delegates of the UCO Bank SC/ST & OBC Employees' Council convened for their prestigious Delegate Session. Imbued with the profound spirit of rural heritage, attendees entered the gorgeous Conference Hall with radiant smiles, resonating powerful slogans of "*Baba Saheb Amar Rahe!*" and "*UCO Bank Zindabad!*"

At 11:45 AM, esteemed functionaries — including President Om Prakash Raigar, General Secretary Shri B. K. Poddar, Chairman of Advisory Committee Shri J. N. 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General Secretary Shri B. K. Poddar subsequently presented the comprehensive Secretary Report along with Audited Accounts from January 2019 to March 2026.

Prior to submitting his report, the General Secretary invited the house to observe two minutes of silence in profound memory of the 43 lives of Ucoites lost during the period of Corona Virus in 2020 & 2021 and our members who passed away during the tenure from 2019 to 2026 including the lives lost for the recent devastating floods in Assam.

To optimize time, the house agreed to focus on key milestones achieved by the Council mentioned in the GS Report:

10. Inclusion of SC/ST Representative in the Interview Board

14. Exemption/Convenient Postings of Office Bearers at Apex Level & State Level
15. Meetings with National Commission and Parliamentary Committee

Treasurer Shri Swapan Mistri then presented the audited Statement of Accounts from January 2019 to March 2026, which received immediate, unanimous approval from

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the delegates chanting "Pass Pass Pass". Shri Mistri highlighted the core philosophy of the Council and urged upon the defaulter State Units to clear their financial dues proactively. He emphasized the imperative of propagating Dr. Ambedkar's egalitarian ideologies.

State-Level Review & Open Discussion

Following a brief tea adjournment, representatives from across the country took the floor to deliberate upon the Secretary Report:

- **Delhi (Shri R. S. Chauhan):** Highlighted persistent branch staffing shortages, unresolved accommodation hurdles, and pending preferential postings.
- **Karnataka (Shri Narayanappa):** Endorsed the Report, noting an increase in state membership to 132.
- **Rajasthan (Shri K. B. Kalaria):** Commended the seven-year legacy of progress, advocating that key executive roles be held by in-service members to align with official corporate guidelines.
- **Uttar Pradesh (Shri Y. P. Goutam & Shri Badri Prasad):** Applauded the West Bengal & Sikkim unit for exceptional conference hospitality, recited inspiring verses on perseverance, and raised Kanpur office infrastructure concerns.
- **Andhra Pradesh & Telangana (Shri K. Venkateswaralu):** Accepted the Report, proposing enhanced digital training avenues for in-service staff.
- **Maharashtra (Shri Milind Wankhede):** Emphasized Dr. Ambedkar's doctrine of "Educate, Agitate, Organize", proposing that 10 percent of State contributions be dedicated to underprivileged social upliftment.
- **Bihar (Shri Yogesh Kumar):** Acknowledged organizational strides while underscoring that senior mentorship remains irreplaceable for the younger cadre.
- **Madhya Pradesh (Shri Darshan Kumar Bagde):** Recommended streamlined Roster maintenance, enhanced cell in charges training, and sensitive handling of retiree matters through senior guidance.
- **Himachal Pradesh (Shri Rohit Kashyap) & Gujarat (Shri Paresh Parmar):** Reaffirmed organizational discipline, celebrated the Council's Golden Jubilee milestones, and advocated for universal implementation of preferential postings.

General Secretary's Reply & Constitutional Amendments

Responding to the queries raised, General Secretary Shri Poddar addressed administrative concerns systematically. He clarified that pending posting adjustments are being pursued through the National Commission, reaffirmed the Council's historical tenacity in securing institutional spaces, and assured that compassionate recruitment and digital training frameworks will be judiciously balanced with management.

The Session then transitioned to the ratification of constitutional amendments. Read aloud sequentially, the house unanimously passed the following structural amendments of By-laws:

A. Amendment In respect of Central Executive Committee:

- a. Considering the increase of membership at all India level, the number of Central Executive Committee is increased up to 61 instead of 41.
- b. A 'Joint General Secretary' post is added.
- c. A 'Vice-Chairman' post is added.
- d. The post of 'Vice President' has been increased to 8.
- e. The post of 'Dy. General Secretary' has been increased to 8.
- f. The post of 'Asst. General Secretary' has been increased to 8.
- g. The post of 'Organising Secretary' has been increased to 8.
- h. 'General Secretary' and 'President' of Central Executive Committee should be from In-service person.
- i. Ratio of Delegates will be 15:1 instead of 10:1 effective from 11th National Conference.
- j. Council's Financial Year will be 'April to March'.
- k. Monthly Subscription of Members has been increased at the following rate with immediate effect :
 - Officers Cadre – ₹160/-
 - Clerical Cadre – ₹80/-
 - Subordinate Cadre (HKP & Peon) – ₹40/-
- l. Inclusion of Vigilance Sub-Committee in the By-laws.
- m. Formation of a Core Committee consisting of 7 (seven) Office Bearers for emergency decision or disciplinary action against any irregularity reported against any State Committee or any other matter deem fit by the General Secretary.

- n. Members of the Advisory Committee & Vigilance sub-committee will be the permanent invitee in the CEC Meeting.

B. Amendment in respect of State Committees:

- The composition of State Executive Committee will vary from 21 (minimum) to 51 (maximum) members keeping the style of portfolio as per by-laws.
- The restriction of 1(one) committee member against 10 (ten) members under check-off system may be applied.
- The 'State Chairman' post may be added to State Committee.
- It is advisable that the posts – 'State Secretary' and 'State President' may be from In-service employees.
- Chairman of State Committee will be ex-officio member of Central Executive Committee.

The Amendments enlisted in 'A' & 'B' above are being incorporated in the By-laws of UCO Bank SC/ST & OBC Employees' Council and enacted with effect from 23rd August, 2026.

Dissolution & Installation of the New Committee

At 6:00 p.m., President Shri O. P. Raigar formally dissolved the existing committee. Shri B. K. Poddar delivered an emotionally resonant farewell address, offering his lifelong blessings to the incoming generation of leaders amidst a prolonged, roaring ovation from the assembly.

Conducted by the distinguished Election Commission — comprising Shri J. N. Kashyap (Ex-DGM), Shri Rajkumar (Ex-DGM) and Shri Nandulkar (DGM) — the house formulated and declared the unanimously elections of the following prime Office Bearers for the next Central Executive Committee 2026-2029 who are entrusted to prepare the whole body of the Committee comprising 61 in number :
